- 1. Shawn opened with prayer followed by a devotional centered on gratitude and patience.

- 3. Amy gave the treasurer's report, we are not hitting the budget as far as income goes. We are off \sim \$14,000 or about 20%. However, our checking account continues to grow.
 - We are over in the finance ministry from the parking lot and there were three paydays instead of two for this period.
 - Reimbursements for education have been paid out. The new one will be towards the end of November.
 - There was also a transfer for the door improvements on the bathroom facilities.

 - Great Lakes offers half tuition to students who receive a paycheck from a local church
 - Proposed a matching fund of half the cost of a semester (\$3,500) Great Lakes will cover the other half of tuition.
 - Dave presented an extra fund for gas allowance, (\$2,500)
 - Sunday, Wednesday, and another day at CrossWalk

- 5. Dave motioned to seek out an intern and set outside \$6,000 to fund this.
 - Motion was seconded by Will Wade

 - Shawn will connect with Cindy on where we are at and what steps are ready to be taken
 - Location for the baptistry plumbing. Is there a possibility to be run from outside for a faster fill?
- 7. Make-it take-it on December 10th from 9-12:30
 - Jeff will start showing videos from previous events before and after service to promote the event.
 - Looking for an update on if we need more crafters
- 8. Caroling will be Wednesday, Dec 21, 2022 5:30-8:00
 - Come at 5:00 for dinner

 - Shawn will call Pauline to get this added to the bulletin
 - Discussion on adopting a family or two to drop gifts and a meal during the event. We have a list to work from if we would like to do this. Mike Hicks proposed the original idea. The team will check with him on pursuing this idea.
